Pastor Lori will speak as part of the clergy and several of our church family will be singing with the San Diego Gay Men's Chorus or the San Diego Women's Chorus, providing music. All are invited!

In addition, we're hoping for great representation at the San Diego Pride Parade. The best way to show San Diego the inclusive, loving nature of PB UMC is to show off our people! Your kind presence makes all the difference in the world! This year we will be organizing rides to and from the parade to minimize the stress of parking and walking to the parade route.
